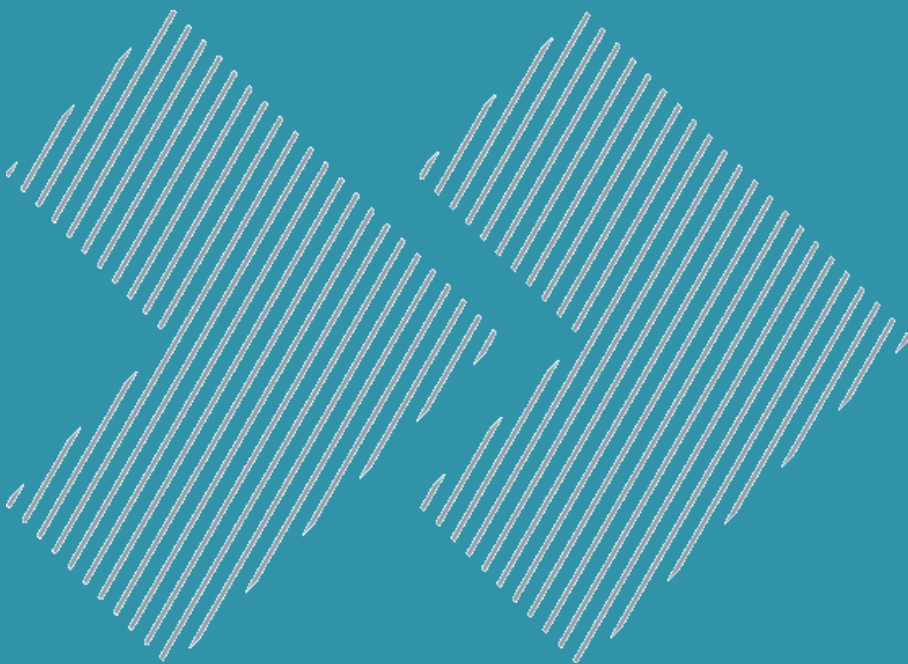


Candidate Workshop



Information for BOSSI Candidates



Consulting Surveyors NSW has been tasked by the Board of Surveying and Spatial Information (BOSSI) to prepare graduates for the registration process.

In New South Wales to become a registered surveyor, you will firstly need to have gained a recognised qualification or equivalent and a Certificate of Competency. The current list of recognised qualifications can be found on the recognised qualifications page of the BOSSI website. If you have gained a qualification that is not on this list it will need to be assessed as an equivalent to a recognised qualification. Further information on qualifications gained outside of Australia and New Zealand can be found on the overseas assessment.

After obtaining your degree you will undertake prescribed training and work experience under the supervision of a registered surveyor and the undertaking of prescribed examinations conducted by the Board. On successful completion of the examinations, a candidate is then accredited by BOSSI as being proficient in the practice of surveying and is entitled to become registered as a land or mining surveyor, under the register held by the Surveyor-General.

Candidates Land Surveyors must take 5 exams:

1. Rural Cadastral
2. Urban Cadastral
3. Town Planning
4. Strata and Community Title Schemes
5. Engineering and Design.

Consulting Surveyors NSW runs workshops twice a year to help candidates prepare for three of these exams. The Rural and Urban Cadastral workshops are run by the Institution of Surveyors NSW.

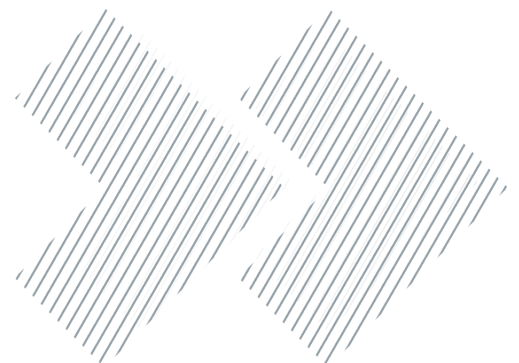

Required reading for every candidate

- First Step: Register with BOSSI as a Candidate Land Surveyor.
- Candidates must have completed 26 weeks BOSSI approved practical experience before sitting a BOSSI examination
- Final Exam undertaken by BOSSI. Candidate must be enrolled and pay directly to BOSSI.
- Application for the final BOSSI Assessment need to be lodged with BOSSI directly.
- All workshops are held at ACS Office: Level 7, 350 Kent Street, Sydney NSW 2000. Mentoring session maybe held online.

- Your own project is recommended. However, if you do not have your own project, please contact ACS office within one week of your enrolment.
- The digital workbook of the workshop will be available after payment.
- Candidates from the same company or working within the same office are NOT allowed to choose the same project.
- You may choose to defer the mid-term assessment but only to the next program.
- We encourage Supervising Surveyors to attend the mid-term assessment session with their candidate. This maybe in person or online.
